

ECTE protocol for COVID-19

- A Physician has been appointed for COVID-19
- Keep the distances of one meter in case we have more people who wish to enter the training area.
- Place solutions (with alcohol content >60%) at the entrance. It is recommended that proper hand hygiene be applied upon entry to the site by staff and students.
- Sharing of pupils in such a way as to avoid overcrowding and to comply with physical distancing measures.
- Daily disinfection of the surfaces (desks, chairs, handles) after each teaching period and change of pupils and other communal areas (e.g. toilet).
- Wash hands by both teaching staff and students before entering and leaving the centre.
- Training course of trainees on precautionary and personal protection measures and to have within the care home a staff team to monitor compliance with the measures.
- Signs in a prominent position indicating the general instructions and instructions for hand washing (such as at the entrance of the rooms, at the entrance of the toilet, etc.).
- Trash bins in each classroom and trash in bags are removed daily.
- During the courses in all rooms there should be continuous ventilation of the space with an open window, which remains open, in order to constantly renew the air in the enclosed spaces.
- Within the room, the distance measures (1 meter and one student per desk and 2 meters from the teacher) should be applied.
- With regard to air conditioners and fans, apply the instructions of the Department of Electromechanical Services.
- In computer rooms, students must observe the safety distance and when entering the classroom wear gloves, which will be thrown in the bins on their way out of the classroom. Students should also be trained not to touch the face as much as possible (especially while wearing gloves).
- The premises should be cleaned daily following cleaning practices with emphasis on the following:

- Regular cleaning and disinfection of frequently used surfaces, such as doorknob, desks, desks, chairs and other furniture with cleaning solution.
- Regular cleaning and disinfection of toilets and surfaces with cleaning solutions (diluted bleach solution)
- Daily floor cleaning with cleaning solutions (preferred diluted bleach solution).
- If any student presents any symptom associated with the symptomatology of the virus, they should not attend the course and the protocol of the Ministry of Health will be followed.
- The appropriate distance between teacher and pupil should be respected.

FOR STUDENTS/ AND EDUCATIONALS

1. Students sit one by one on each desk.
2. The desks must be at least one meter away from each other.
3. Students should not use the desks of their classmates during the course.
4. Do not exchange objects with each other by pupils and teachers (pen, notebooks, markers, etc.).
5. The teacher's handling area must be at least 2 meters from the nearest desk.
6. It is recommended to use a mask where the two (2) meters of distance are not observed.
7. Students should go straight to the classroom, which will be known in advance.
8. Keep a distance between the teacher and the student, which will be at least two (2) meters, so that the course can be conducted smoothly.
9. In computer rooms, students do not use computers in between the course that have not been disinfected.
10. In courses requiring the use of computers, each computer should be used only by one student and there should be a distance of one metre between each computer.
11. In pupil reception areas, no gatherings of many pupils are allowed in order to comply with safety measures and pupils are encouraged to use their masks.
